



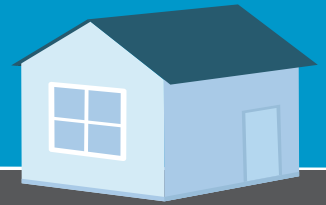

1982 Jessie's Centre for Teenagers opens at 154 Bathurst St.



1989 Jessie's is instrumental in organizing **Housing Equality for Youth (HEY)** to ensure the enforcement of the provisions in the 1986 amendments to the Human Rights Code.

1991 Jessie's relocates to **205 Parliament Street**, a centre that includes **16 self-contained non-profit housing units**.



1998 Jessie's **Community Education Program (CEP)** begins.

2002 Jessie's launches a **scholarship program** for school graduates pursuing post-secondary education. **Recipients receive \$500 each. In 2021, the amount is increased to \$1,000.**



2008 Jessie's Centre for Teenagers becomes **June Callwood Centre for Women and Families**.

2012 The Nursery becomes **Jessie's Parent Child Centre** with an emphasis on infant mental health and our name changes to **Jessie's - The June Callwood Centre for Young Women**.



2016 Age of intake increases to **19 years and under**.

2017 Jessie's launches the radio show **Powerful X Nature**, hosted by participants.



2022 Programs are delivered **both in-person and virtually**, increasing accessibility and removing barriers. Age of intake **increases to 21** and under. Jessie's releases **new Mission and Vision statements** to guide our next **40 years**.
