1982 **Jessie's Centre for Teenagers** opens at 154 Bathurst St.



Jessie's is instrumental in organizing Housing Equality for Youth (HEY) to ensure the enforcement of the provisions in the 1986 amendments to the Human Rights Code.

Jessie's relocates to 205 Parliament Street, a centre that includes 16 self-contained non-profit housing units.



Jessie's Community Education Program (CEP) begins.

2002

Jessie's launches a scholarship program for school graduates pursuing post-secondary education. Recipients receive \$500 each. In 2021, the amount is increased to \$1,000.



2008 Jessie's Centre for Teenagers becomes
June Callwood Centre for Word June Callwood Centre for Women and Families.

The Nursery becomes Jessie's Parent Child Centre with an emphasis on infant mental health and our name changes to Jessie's - The June Callwood Centre for Young Women.

Age of intake increases to 19 years and under.

2017

Jessie's launches the radio show Powerful X Nature, hosted by participants.



2022

Programs are delivered **both in-person** and virtually, increasing accessibility and removing barriers. Age of intake increases to 21 and under. Jessie's releases new Mission and Vision statements to guide our next 40 years.
